



ECO TAKE OUT CONTAINERS PROGRAM Practices and Procedures

In an ongoing effort to reduce the carbon footprint at Wells College, a reusable takeout container program is now available as the only takeout option for the Wells College Dining Hall. This Eco Friendly solution will continue to offer dining flexibility.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

1. Enroll in the Eco Take Out Container Program by completing this agreement and paying a \$20 enrollment fee for two (2) 9x9 3-Compartment Container and two (2) 12oz Sealable Bowls.
2. You will receive one (1) of each container for your initial use and the other will be ready for you when you exchange. You may also opt to carry our green Eco To Go carabiner that can be exchanged for a clean container when you arrive at the dining location.
3. You will receive a sticker for your Wells ID Card identifying you as an active participant in the program. This sticker must accompany all container & carabiner exchanges.
4. When you arrive at the Dining Hall, you will exchange your rinsed-out container(s), or carabiner for a clean and sanitized replacement. The cashier will ask that you present your Wells student ID showing that you have been registered in the program.
5. Prepare your meal and close all lids tightly. By participating in the program you are forfeiting your option for all you care to eat dining and must not eat in the dining room in addition to your take out meal. Those found abusing the privilege of the program will be charged for an additional meal based on the casual door rates.
6. You are welcome to bring your own personal beverage container to fill (maximum 32oz capacity).
7. After you have prepared your meal to go, stop by the cashier to pick up your napkin and disposable eating utensils.
8. Enjoy your meal, rinse out your container when you are done and return to the Dining Hall to exchange it for a clean and sanitized replacement or carabiner.
9. Green Eco To Go carabiners may be clipped to backpacks in lieu of carrying your containers. You may also choose to exchange containers for a carabiner at the end of each semester to have over the break periods.

THE CONTAINER

The container is made of a BPA free plastic material that is refrigerator, freezer and microwave safe. The container is light-weight, sturdy and spill resistant. All containers must be returned from a previous visit and be free of damage due to excessive use/abuse. Lost or damaged containers due to abuse can be replaced for \$6 -9x9 3-Compartment Container and \$4 -12oz Sealable Bowl. Lost Carabiners can be replaced for \$1.50. Proof of program membership is required for all replacements.
